Family Services

Children of Inmates Care Coordination Center

Outreach to 125 children and their families who are impacted by incarceration. Services include family counseling, benefits restoration, basic needs referral, video conferencing and prison visitation.

Encourages young people to set personal goals for their future, thereby helping them to avoid high-risk behaviors which can lead to teen pregnancy.

In three years, Project U-Turn has reached over 18,000 public school teens with practical training.
